In the competition for "associate professor" announced in the State Newspaper , issue 1/2014 40 of 14.05.2021 and on the website of Plovdiv University "Paisii Hilendarski" for the needs of the Department of Pedagogy and Education Management at the Faculty of Pedagogical, Ivan Vasilev Trichkov from Plovdiv University "Paisii Hilendarski" participated as a candidate.

1. General presentation of the procedure and the applicant

By order No P33-3143 of 13.07.2021 of the Rector of plovdiv University "Paisii Hilendarski" (PU) I am appointed as a member of the scientific jury of a competition for the academic position "Associate Professor" in the University of Higher Education 3. Social, Economic and Legal Sciences, Professional Strand 3.2. Psychology (Special Psychology), declared for the needs of the Department of Pedagogy and Management of Education at the Faculty of Education. The award was awarded by decision of the Scientific Jury, determined by order of the Rector of Plovdiv University "Paisii Hilendarski".

The only candidate in the competition is Chief assistant Dr. Ivan Vasilev Trichkov from Plovdiv University "Paisii Hilendarski". The submitted documents meet the basic requirements of the

Academic Staff Development Act in the Republic of Bulgaria and the Regulations for its implementation for the academic position "Associate Professor".

The information submitted by the Chief assistant Dr. . Ivan Vasilev Trichkov kit of paper materials is in accordance with the Rules for Development of the Academic Staff of the University of National and World Art and includes the following documents:

1. Application on a model to the Rector for admission to the competition;
2. Cv according to European format;
3. Diploma of howl education with acquired degree "Master" - original with application or notarized copy;
4. Diploma of educational and scientific degree "Doctor" - original or notarized copy;
5. List of scientific papers;
6. Reference to compliance with the minimum national and additional faculty requirements (if any);
7. Annotations of the materials under Art. 65. from the PRASPU, including self-assessment of contributions;
8. Declaration of originality and reliability of the attached documents;
9. Certificate of service;
10. Documents for study work;
11. Research documents;
12. Other documents.
13. Set of paper documents from item 1 to item 12-3 pieces;
14. Set of documents of item 1, 2, 6, 7, 8 (possible indication of other documents of item 4, 5, 11, 12) in electronic form - 8 pieces.

The candidate, Chief assistant Dr. Ivan Vasilev Trichkov has applied a total of 32 scientific works, 4 studies, 3 monographs, 3 textbooks and teaching tools and a list of 9 research developments. All scientific works that are outside the dissertation and are reported in the final evaluation are considered to be reviewed: 3 teaching aids and 9 research projects. 4 scientific papers on the dissertation and scientific papers outside the issues of the competition are not reviewed. The distribution of scientific papers in relevant headings, at home and abroad, as follows:

- Three monographs,
- Two Articles, scientific reports, scientific communications, referenced and indexed in a world-renowned database of scientific production,

- Twenty articles and scientific reports in Bulgaria and abroad in unreferenced journals with scientific review;
- Four scientific studies;
- Three textbooks and teaching aids.

Documents (in the form of business notes) for participation and implementation of developments in national projects "Qualification of pedagogical staff" and projects to the NDP, their benefit and data on the resulting economic effect are also presented.

The complete familiarization with the project and scientific and applied activities of the Chief assistant Dr. Ivan Trichkov gives a reason to give a positive assessment of the qualities of the production and the fruitful diligence of the applicant.

2. General characteristics of the applicant's activities

Ivan Trichkov is a Doctor of Special Psychology with a Doctorate on "Empathy in the Structure of Social Skills in Hyperactive Children", Master of Advisory Psychology and Bachelor's degree in Pedagogy from Plovdiv University "Paisii Hilendarski". He has acquired qualifications in the field of Criminalization, Socialization, Integration, Reintegration, as well as in the field of Intercultural Education at universities in the country and abroad. Participates and manages a number of national projects related to the qualification of pedagogical specialists. He works as a trainer and lecturer at Plovdiv University "Paisii Hilendarski". Chief assistant Dr. Ivan Trichkov teaches the disciplines Special Psychology, Inclusive Education, Psychodiagnostics, Psychological interventions in working with children and students with behavioral and emotional disorders. He is fluent in Russian and English.

With regard to the minimum national requirements for the groups of indicators for the position of "associate professor" the candidate shows in his reports that he/she owns them. Ivan Trichkov presents the following habilitating works (monographs):

- "Psychological aspects of empathy in children and students with hyperactivity syndrome and attention deficit", 2021, "Paisii Hilendarski" Secondary School – ISBN 978-619-202-514-4
- "Psychological-pedagogical rules, models of good practices and recommendations in the work and training of children and students with behavioral disorders", published in 2019, "Paisii Hilendarski" Secondary School – ISBN 978-619-202-296-9
- "Teacher Attitudes towards the Inclusion of Children and Students with SOPs in a Social Educational Environment", issued 2017, Paisii Hilendarski Primary School – ISBN 978-619-202-665-3

According to indicator D, with a minimum required 200 points, the applicant exceeds them. Chief assistant Dr. Trichkov presents 22 articles, 4 studies and 3 textbooks and teaching aids.

The candidate's scientific materials are published in peer-reviewed journals and collections. They are cited by other authors, which satisfies the criterion of minimum national requirements. The applicant collects a sufficient number of points from citations of his or her work in articles and monographs, as well as from participation in research projects.

The candidate has teaching, scientific and professional experience in connection with the announced competition. The original contribution of Ivan Trichkov is also found in the publications in co-authorship through the specific style of exhibition and the expressed scientific interests.

It should be noted that the peer reviews submitted have not been submitted for participation in other procedures for scientific degrees and academic positions.

Chief assistant Dr. Ivan Trichkov presents scientific production, which is characterized by methodological support and precision. The way results are developed and presented, style, language and external form meet the requirements and standards for academic publications. The works presented for participation in the competition provide a good way to accumulate knowledge, to master a categorized-concept apparatus, and to develop creative thinking in students.

In the works of the competition, I found no attempts to present works written in part or created by another for their own, or the use of foreign scientific results, without reference or citation. I do not know that there are claims by other authors of improper use of literary sources, or that signals have been received about the publications of the plagiarism candidate.

3. Critical remarks and recommendations

Assessment of educational and pedagogical activities

- The thorough familiarization with the teaching and scientifically applied activities of the Ch. ace. Dr. Ivan Trichkov gives reason to draw the following conclusions about his qualities, namely:
- He has gained experience as a lecturer, head of exercises and seminars. He also organizes at a modern methodological level and conducts the assigned educational and pedagogical activity.
- He has developed a course of lectures and teaching materials on the topic of the announced competition.
- Combines the educational and pedagogical work with scientific and applied research in the field of special psychology, successfully and with good results.

- His scientific appearances create the necessary publicity of his activities to the scientific public.

Evaluation of the applicant's scientific and scientific and applied activities

Habilitation works meet the author's goal and draw attention to socio-psychological constructs that are significant for the functioning of man. They are a serious theoretical analytical study. The issues related to the impact of social attitudes on attitudes towards children with special educational needs and children with hyperactivity have been analyzed. In depth, current issues related to the construction "empathy" and its relationships with basic Az-processes, social and cultural factors and developed processes are also considered.

The applicant has provided publications, textbooks and teaching aids on a number of other problems in the field of special psychology and pedagogy, which establish him as a competent researcher in the fields: emotional and behavioral disorders typical of childhood and adolescence; therapeutic models for working with students and family support for children with emotional behavioral deficits. In the development of the program Chief assistant Dr. Ivan Trichkov skillfully presented ways to optimize and implement interactive and innovative psychological-pedagogical rules and models of good practices in the training of children with behavioral disorders.

Contributions (scientific, scientific and applied, applied)

- The contributions to the work of Chief assistant Dr. Ivan Trichkov can generally be characterized as:
 - revealing and proving new essential parties and characteristics of current and relevant practices for special psychology and their application in society;
 - formulating new ideas, concepts and approaches;
 - knowledge of the scientific problems being treated.

Scientific contributions in work are in the professional field of "Psychology", special psychology. They have been obtained as a result of summarizing the Chief assistant Dr. Ivan Trichkov studies and can be found in the scientific publications presented to review the competition. They are important for understanding the essence and content of special psychology contributions. They can be summarized as follows:

1. The impact of psychosocial factors on attention deficit hyperactivity syndrome and related experiences and behaviors as well as the opportunities for impact on them is investigated.
2. New knowledge received and significant summaries in tracking and comparative analysis of groups of children in norm, behavioral disorders and children with attention hyperactivity syndrome.
3. Some aspects of health and mental regulation of the behavior of students with special educational needs have been studied.
4. New knowledge has been obtained and analysis of empathy events for students.

Detailed acquaintance with the applicant's documents shows that it has significant organizational and research experience and has established itself as a successful practice in the preparation and implementation of scientific and applied current and significant research.

To the applicant's activity as a lecturer I have no remarks. To his appearances as a scientist as well. The applicant makes a good impression that the wild scientific research field helps for the appearance as a scientist and I would recommend keeping and improving the expertise in this respect.

CONCLUSION

The documents and materials presented by Ivan Vassilev Trichkov meet all the requirements of the Academic Composition Act in the Republic of Bulgaria, the Regulations for the Implementation of the Plug and the Rules of Procedure of Paisii Hilendarski.

The candidate in the competition has submitted a sufficient number of scientific work posted after the materials used in the protection of the AS doctor. The applicant's work has original scientific and applied contributions. Some of them are published in magazines and scientific collections issued by international academies. His theoretical developments have practical applicability, as part of them are directly oriented towards learning. Scientific and teaching qualification of Ch. AC. Dr. Ivan Vassilev Trichkov are undoubtful.

Achieved by Ivan Vassilev Trichkov results in scientific-research field, **fully** conform to the PU Rules for Application.

After examining the materials and scientific works presented in the competition, an analysis of their significance and scientific, scientific and applied contributions contained in them, I find reasonable to give my positive assessment and recommend the scientific jury to prepare a report to the faculty Board of the Faculty of Pedagogy for Choice of Chief. Assoc. Prof. Ivan Vassilev Trichkov on the academic position 'Associate Professor' in Pu 'P. Hilendarski "in the field of higher education 3.
