1. General presentation of the candidate's procedure

With order № RD-21-74 dated 18.01.2023 of the Rector of Plovdiv University "Paisii Hilendarski" (PU), I was appointed member of the scientific jury of a competition for taking the academic position of "Associate Professor" in PU, in area of higher education 8. Arts, professional trend 8.3 The art of music and dance (History of music), announced for the needs of the Department of Music as part of the Pedagogical Faculty.

Chief Assist. Prof. Zdravka Marinova Hvarkata, PhD, from PU "Paisii Hilendarski", has submitted documents for participation in the competition.

The set of materials on paper submitted by Chief Assist. Prof. Zdravka Marinova Hvarkata, PhD complies with the Rules for developing the academic staff of PU. The candidate enclosed 1 habilitation paper - a monograph, 1 report published in a referenced and indexed scientific journal, 27 articles and reports published in specialized journals, out of these 23 in Bulgaria and 4 abroad, 4 treatises in specialized journals in the sphere of art, a second monograph, a book on the ground of a defended dissertation paper, 1 textbook and 1 university manual for studying.

There are presented also documents (letters of gratitude, certificates and office references) for participation in research and creativity projects.

Brief CV data

I have known Chief Assist. Prof. Zdravka Marinova Hvarkata, PhD for 14 years. She is an excellent lecturer, outgoing and sociable. An incorrigible professional, she has a 35-year teaching experience, supported by solid educational background. From the submitted CV and diplomas for the education she graduated, it is evident that she finished "Dobri Hristov" high school of music, her specialty being piano; three Master studies in the Bulgarian State Conservatoire and Sofia University "St. Kliment Ohridsky" (choir conducting, musicology and law) and she also defended a PhD in "Pancho Vladigerov" NAM. She speaks 4 foreign languages, with average level of competence.

2. General characteristics of the candidate's activity

The academic-and-pedagogical activity of the candidate includes designing and delivering new lecture courses and designing curricula in 6 theoretical and 1 practical-and-applied disciplines.

Her research activity is linked to participating in research and creativity projects like "The wording of young people" - 2015, "Academic readings" - 2013, 2014, 2015, 2021, "Alternatives in education" - 2016 and "Innovative educational environment" - 2017.

Assessment for compliance with the minimum state requirements

The minimum national requirements presented in the table, scope a period of time after 1997 when the candidate was taking the academic position "Chief Assistant". They are as follows:

- 11. Published university study manual or manual which is used in the school network 2 manuals (40 p.)

Total points in group "F" -175 p.

The reference is made correctly and in compliance with the parameters in the Rules for applying the Law for developing the academic staff in the Republic of Bulgaria.

The above-mentioned activities definitely have a value of contribution which exceeds many times the requirements for taking the academic position of "Associate Professor" in PT 8.3. The art of music and dance (History of music). The requirement is for 360 and the achieved points are 1 145.

CONCLUSION
