1. General presentation of the procedure and the candidate

Brief biographical data of the candidate

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Tanya Vazova graduated from the University of National and World Economy. In 2018, she defended her doctoral dissertation in Economics and Labor Management. Her career is primarily focused on providing consultations and services in the social sphere. Dr. Vazova is a researcher with an established professional status. As a person and colleague, she impresses with her temperament, collegiality, responsibility and consistency. She has excellent presentation skills and is able to inspire and stimulate colleagues, students and PhD candidates.

2. General characteristics of the candidate's activities

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Tanya Vazova teaches a number of disciplines in the field of Social Activities. She works actively with students and teachers. She regularly participates in training to improve her qualifications. She has enviable experience in working on projects.

The monograph "Social Services for Adults and Elderly People in Bulgaria: Development, Challenges, Prospects" (2024) examines psychosocial aspects of services for adults. The proposed detailed analysis of social policies in this area allows to outline prospects for development. The articles proposed for the needs of the competition are grouped into several thematic areas:

1. Formation and development of personal and professional competencies among social workers

2. Improving the quality of life of the elderly

3. Complex policies aimed at the elderly

4. Social services and innovations

The contributions (scientific, applied science, applied) and citations can be summarized as follows:

1. Research on the regulatory framework and social policies for the elderly and the elderly.

2. Improving the quality of social services through support models for working with the elderly and people with disabilities.

3. Development of key competencies of specialists in the field of social services.

The presented scientific works are original scientific developments. The predominant part of the research conducted was conducted independently, and those in which he worked in collaboration, show teamwork skills in planning, conducting the research and summarizing the results. The submitted documentation, including the noted citations, are in order and meet all criteria within the meaning of the procedure for conducting this competition.

3. Critical remarks and recommendations
